Mission Aircraft In The Field Receive Upgrade

Worldwide, the entire fleet of Mission Aviation Fellowship (MAF) aircraft are currently undergoing an upgrade to their tracking equipment using the v2tracking system. This hybrid system uses both satellite and cellular networks to automatically transmit a pilot's location. This system also removes the dependency on HF radio for tracking airplanes. The primary benefit is streamlining of flight operations and quicker response for emergencies.
