Acceptable devices: iPhone 6 and higher, iPad 4th generation and higher. Android 6.0 or higher .



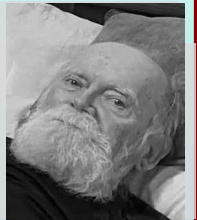
## MATA End-of-Year Video Report
