

Christian School Students Given Tools to Proclaim Jesus



"VERY WELL DONE" was the feedback we received from Principle Austin after we delivered chapel presentations to **Grace Academy**, a Christian school located in Marysville, on March 22nd. Becky (photo above) spoke to Kindergarten through 3rd graders, and Clayton (photo, below right) spoke to the 4th through 6th graders at separate chapel services. We were told that not very often do missionaries come and speak to the students. We felt very honored to receive an invitation to be their featured speakers concerning the Gospel and missions to an attendance count of about 250 children. It was especially encouraging to have many students take notes!





More than 80 of the 4th through 6th graders were provided Jesus Film gift cards. We challenged them to later pray and ask God to reveal which people they could give the gift cards to. Students were encouraged to not keep Jesus to themselves but to be sure that gift cards be given to those who need Him.

On March 23rd, twenty-five 5th grade students from **Grace Academy** came for a tour of MATA (photos below). MATA staff engaged the students in handson activities including riveting, working with metal, torque, and preflight. Clayton presented several videos about how and why MATA trains the next generation of missionary pilots, and also showed what exactly a missionary pilot does on their field assignment.
