Hundreds of unchurched families came to this event which is sponsored by the city airport and located next to their offices. Families came to see police cars, fire trucks, airplanes, community booths, and receive free flights for children through the Young Eagles program. MATA staff & students built more than 150 candy airplanes for children who received evangelistic Bible verses and free gift cards to watch the Children's Jesus Film online. Once again we invited CEF (Child Evangelism Fellowship) to partner with us in the MATA booth. CEF painted more than 128 faces with most children (and their parents looking on) accepting the offer to hear a Bible story. One of the children that came said they had never heard of Jesus and had no idea who He is. Another precious child made the decision to pray and ask Jesus into their life for salvation! The angels in heaven paused to rejoice over this one child. Your teamwork allows us to give God glory for His purposes.
