## MATA Alum lan Rojas featured in MAF's weekly email.

Our good friend and MATA alum Ian Rojas and wife Greta will be stateside soon as they take a break from their mission assignment for the birth of their first baby. Ian serves with MAF (Mission Aviation Fellowship) in Kalimantan, Indonesia, piloting the Kodiak airplane (which has a purchase price of \$2.2 million USD!). MAF recently featured Ian in their weekly email describing a typical flight day...

"Pilot Ian Rojas listed off his passengers at each stop and the work they were doing.

- A team from the church in Long Lebusan going to Long Ampung to raise funds for a new church building in Lebusan.
- A work crew heading into the Apo Kayan to continue a building project for a new bridge in Long Sule.
- Two pastors heading to Tarakan for a missions seminar taking place at the local GKII church.
- One more pastor planning to attend the seminar, along with some regular passengers traveling to Tanjung Selor.

While Ian was completing his flights, MAF pilots Lance and Walton were in another Kodiak responding to two medevac requests from Malinau; one patient heading to the larger hospital in Samarinda, the other to Tarakan.

'Serving together to support the work of community development, help with multiple church events, and respond to two emergency medical needs is exactly what we are here to do,' said Ian. 'I thought to myself that this had to be the quintessential MAF Kalimantan day.'

Ian says he flew 436 miles, and Lance flew 691 [serving the peoples of Kalimantan, Indonesia]." Mission aviation impacting lives!
